

SCB Bylaws

Article I: Name and Purpose

The name of this organization shall be SCB.

The purpose of SCB is to foster community, fellowship, and shared celebration among its members.

Article II: Membership

1. Eligibility:

Membership is open to individuals who support the mission and values of SCB.

2. Probationary Period:

All new members shall serve a 90-day probationary membership period. During this time, participation and compatibility with the organization's culture will be observed before full membership is granted.

3. Membership Approval:

In order to gain membership, a prospective member must receive 100% consensus from all current full members.

4. Founding Members:

The Founding Members of SCB are:

- Rome Malloy
- Melissa Malloy
- Jason Colon

5. Membership Responsibilities:

All members are expected to actively participate in group activities, uphold the organization's values, and treat everyone with dignity and respect. Members must hold themselves to the highest standards and represent SCB with integrity.

6. Conduct and Removal:

Membership may be revoked at any time for any of the following reasons:

- Non-participation in multiple events
- Conduct unbecoming of SCB's values
- Failure to treat others with dignity and respect
- Any actions that embarrass or discredit SCB

Removal of a member will be based on a discussion and vote by the full members, requiring a majority decision.

Article III: Celebrations

1. Birthday Celebrations:

SCB shall hold a birthday celebration each month to honor all members born in that month.

2. Planning:

Celebrations will take place at a location and time agreed upon by the group each month. Founding members or their designee will coordinate logistics.

Article IV: Amendments

These bylaws may be amended by consensus of the founding members or a majority vote of all full members, provided notice has been given at least one week in advance.

Article V: Dues and Membership Process

1. Dues:

Yearly dues are \$200, payable in full or in monthly installments of \$25 from January through August. Paying for the entire year in advance is the preferred method.

2. Prospective Member Sponsorship:

Prospective members must be sponsored by a current member. Their case for membership must be presented and discussed at a face-to-face meeting with at least a majority of current members present.

3. Annual Event Attendance:

Participation in annual events—such as the White Elephant celebration in December—is expected of all members. Attendance by all or a majority of members is required.
